- 2. With reference to IWF-Masters Rule 2.4 Minimum Starting Attempts Total, the 10/15 Kilo Rule will apply.
- 3. Athletes <u>must produce</u> a passport or Australian Driver's Licence at the weigh-in. Failure to submit correct ID at the weigh-in will result in the athlete not being able to contest the event.
- 4. Athletes may compete in the category in which they have been entered or go up or down categories.
