AWF Technical Official - Upgrade Information Fact Sheet

- 1. Upgrades from National to International Category 2, or from International Category 2 to International Category 1 can only be undertaken at the following events (unless otherwise notified by the AWF).
 - a. The AWF Australian U15 and Youth Championships.
 - b. The AWF Australian Junior and Senior Championships.
- 2. Applications to upgrade must be received by the AWF Technical Committee no later than 60 days before each event. Applications are to be sent to Phil Maunder at phil.maunder@gmail.com
- 3. The application must detail all criteria listed in the upgrade matrix above. Applications that don't fulfil the criteria will not be considered.
- 4. The AWF will notify applicants of their success or otherwise to be considered for an upgrade no later than 30 days before the scheduled event.
